PART.I SECTION - I INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERER

1. Submission of Bids:-

Sealed tenders in duplicate in on single part each complete with all respect, in the manner hereinafter specified are to be submitted in the office of SR.GENERAL MANAGER [S&S.]OPTCL, Bhubaneswar on or before the date and time specified against the relevant tender Specification in the notice inviting the tenders. Each copy of the bids (Original & Duplicate) shall be in separate double sealed envelopes super scribed on each of the covers the relevant tender Specification number and the due date of opening of the bids on the right hand top side of the envelopes. On the left top sides original/duplicate as is relevant, shall be written.

2. Division of Specification:

The Specification is mainly divided into one part viz. Part-I.

Part- I Consists of

3. Tenders shall be in single Part:

The Tenderers are required to submit the tenders in single-part in double sealed covers shall be superscribed as 16.M.D., technical and commercial+ and shall be superscribed as 16. where the bid+.

4. Opening of Bids.

i) The tender shall be opened in the office of the Sr.General Manager [S&S.]OPTCL in presence of such of the Tenderers or their authorized representatives (limited to one

person only) on the due date of opening of tender and after scrutiny of the technical particulars and other commercial terms, clarifications as may be required, shall be sought for from the bidders. The Tenderers shall be allowed 15 days time for such activity.

- ii) On receipt of technical clarification the bids shall be reviewed/evaluated and those not in conformity with the technical Specification/qualifying experience, shall be rejected. If any of the technical proposals requires modification to make them comparable, discussion will be held with the participating bidders.
- iii) The bidders are required to furnish sufficient information to the Purchaser to establish their qualification/capability to manufacture and/or supply the materials/perform the work. Such information shall include details of biddercs experience, its financial, managerial and technical capabilities.
- iv) The bidders are also required to furnish details of availability of appropriate technical staff and capability to perform after sales service where applicable. The above information shall be considered during the first stage of scrutiny and evaluation of bids and any bid which does not satisfactorily meet these requirements, shall not be considered for price bid evaluation.

5. <u>Purchaser's Right Regarding Alteration of Quantities Tendered.</u>

The Purchaser may alter the quantities of materials/equipment at the time of placing orders. Initially the Purchaser may place order for lesser quantity with full freedom to place extension orders for further quantity under similar terms and conditions of the original orders. Order may also be split among more than one Tenderer for any particular item if considered necessary in the interest of the Purchaser.

6. <u>Procedure & Opening Time of Tenders</u>:

Tenders will be opened in the office of the Sr.General Manager [S&S.]OPTCL, on the specified date and time in presence of such of the Tenderers or their authorized representatives (limited to one person only) in case of each bidders who may desire to be present, at the time of opening the bids. The Sr.General Manager [S&S.]OPTCL, or his authorized representatives will, on opening of each bid, read aloud the name of the bidder. He shall also read aloud the attested and un-attested corrections and shall record the number of such corrections on each page of the technical bid over his dated initials and also initial all such corrections.

7. Bidder's Liberty to Deviate from Specification:

The Tenderer may deviate from the Specification while quoting if in his opinion such deviation is in the line with the manufactureros standard practice and conducive to a better and more economical offer. All such deviations should however be clearly indicated giving full justifications for such deviation. (Read with Clause-9, Section-II of the Specification).

Eligibility for Submission of Bids.

Tenderers who have purchased the Specification from the office or downloaded from the official website of OPTCL & deposited the tender cost while submitting the tender will only be considered.

9. Purchaser's Right to Accept/Reject Bids.

The purchaser reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reasons what so ever if it is in the interest of OPTCL under the existing circumstances. (Read with Clause-10, Section-II of the Specification).

10. <u>Mode of Submission of Bids</u>.

- ii) Bids, complete in all respect shall be submitted in person or by registered Post with A.D. Any other mode shall not be accepted. When delivered in person, the tenders shall be received by a responsible officer of the office of the Sr.General Manager [S&S.]OPTCL who shall officially acknowledge the receipt of the same. Tenders received after due date and time shall be returned un-opened.
- iii) <u>Telegraphic, Telephonic or FAX Tenders</u> shall not be accepted under any circumstances.

11. (i) Earnest Money Deposit.

The tender shall be accompanied by Earnest Money Deposit of value specified in the notice inviting tenders against each lot/bid. Tenders without the required E.M.D. will be rejected outright.

The earnest money deposit shall be furnished in one of the following forms subject to the conditions mentioned below:

- (a) Bank Draft: To be drawn in favour of the GM,Stores Circle, OPTCL,Bhubaneswar.
- (b) Bank Guarantee from any nationalized/scheduled Bank strictly as per enclosed proforma vide Annexure-VI to be executed on non-judicial stamp paper of appropriate value worth 29/- to be accompanied by the confirmation letter of the issuing Bank.

The validity of the E.M.D. Bank Guarantee shall be 240 days from the date of opening of tender, failing which the tender will be liable for rejection.

- No adjustment towards Earnest Money Deposit shall be permitted against any outstanding amount with the Odisha Power Transmission Corporation Limited
- j) In the case of un-successful Tenderer the Earnest Money will be refunded Immediately after the tender is decided. In the case of successful tenderer, EMD will be refunded only after furnishing of security money referred to at Clause-19 of section . II. Suits if any, arising out of this Clause shall be filed in a Court of law to which the jurisdiction of high court of Odisha extends.
- k) Earnest Money will be forfeited if the Tenderer fails to accept the letter of intent and /or purchase orders issued in his favour.

12. Validity of the Bids

The tenders should be kept valid for a period of 180 days from the date of opening of the tender as notified in the tender notice failing which the tenders will be rejected.

13. **PRICE** Tenderers are requested to quote FIRM price only including all taxes & duties except service tax.

14. Revision of Tender Price By Bidders

- 3 After opening of tenders and within the validity period, no reduction or Enhancement in price will be entertained. If there is any change in price, the tender shall stand rejected and E.M.D. deposited shall be forfeited. In case of bidders who are exempted from depositing E.M.D. and who revise their price within the validity period, the bids for similar items against subsequent tender call notice of OPTCL, may not be considered.
- 4 If required, the Tenderers may be asked to extend the validity period of bids under the same terms and conditions as per the original tender except for the change in delivery period, In such an event the Tenderers are free to change any or all conditions of their bids including price at their own risk.

15. <u>Tenderers to be fully Conversant with the Clauses of the Specification.</u>

Tenderers are expected to be fully conversant with the meaning of all the Clauses of the Specification before submitting their tenders. In case of doubt regarding the meaning of any Clause the Tenderer may seek clarification in writing from the Sr.General Manager (S&S), OPTCL. - w) Erasures and other changes shall bear the dated initial of the person signing the tender.
- x) In the event of discrepancy or arithmetical error in the schedule of price, the decision of the Purchaser shall be final and binding on the Tenderer.

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT (G.T.C.C)

1.0 Scope of the Contract

1.1 Internal concealed wiring of light, fan, plug points, Power plug, Computer points etc for Transit House, Bhoinagar, OPTCL, BBSR.

Supply & fixing of BDBs, MDB & Computer DB box etc for Transit House, Bhoinagar, OPTCL, BBSR.

Supply & fixing of Street light fittings with bulb in the entrance gate of Transit House, Bhoinagar, OPTCL, BBSR.

Provision of DG Supply to the light & computer points of Ground floor & 1st floor of Transit House, Bhoinagar,OPTCL,BBSR.

The details of list is at Schedule of Price (Annexure-A). The rate quoted should be considered the dismantling of existing wiring & keeping the scrap materials within you if available. The bidders are requested to inspect the site before quoting the rate in the bid.

2.0 Definition of Terms

For the purpose of this Specification and General Terms & Conditions of Contract (G.T.C.C.) the following words shall have the meanings hereby indicated, except where otherwise described or defined.

- 2.1 %The Purchaser+ shall mean the Sr.General Manager (S&S) for & on behalf of ODISHA POWER TRANSMISSION CORPORATION LTD., Bhubaneswar.
- 2.2 %The Engineer+shall mean the engineer appointed by the Purchaser for the purpose of this contract.
- 1.1 %Rurchaserc Representative+ shall mean any person or persons or consulting firm appointed and remunerated by the Purchaser to supervise, inspect, test and examine workmanship and materials of the equipment to be supplied.
- 1.2 %The Contractor+shall mean the Bidder whose bid has been accepted by the Purchaser and shall include the Biddersqexecutives, Administrators, Successors and permitted assignees.
- 1.3 % quipment+shall mean and include all machinery, apparatus, Materials, articles to be provided under the contract by the Contractor.

- 1.4 Contract Price+shall mean the sum named in or calculated in accordance with the provisions of the contract as the Contract Price+which shall include packing, forwarding, freight, insurance excise duty, sales tax, Octroi and other taxes and duties as applicable at the time of opening of bids.
- 1.5 % General Conditions+shall mean these General Terms and Conditions of Contract.
- 1.6 Whe Specification+shall mean the Specification annexed to or issued with G.T.C.C. and shall include the schedules & drawings attached thereto as well as all samples and pattern, if any.
- 1.7 %Month+shall mean %Galendar month+.
- 1.8 %Writing+ shall include any manuscript, type written, printed or other statement re-production in any visible form and whether under seal or under hand.
- 1.9 % O.R. Destination Costs+ shall mean the cost of equipment and material at the consignee stores. The cost is exclusive of Excise duty, Sales Tax and other Local Taxes, but is inclusive of packing, forwarding and insurance and freight charges.
- 1.10 The term Contract documents+shall mean and include G.T.C.C., Specifications, Schedules, Drawings, Form of Tender, Covering Letter, Schedule of Price of the final successful bidder any special conditions applicable to the particular contract, Specifications and drawings and the purchase order & the agreement to be entered into.
- 1.11 Terms and Conditions not herein defined shall have the same meaning as are assigned to them in the Indian Contract Act, failing that, in the Odisha General Clauses Act.

3. Manner of Execution

All works completed under the contract shall be manufactured in the manner set out in the Specification or where not set out, to the reasonable satisfaction of the Purchaser representative.

.4. Inspection and Testing

- i) The Purchaserqs representative shall be entitled at all reasonable times during manufacture to inspect, examine and test on the Contractorqs premises the materials and workmanship of all equipment to be supplied under this contract and if part of the said equipment is being manufactured on other premises, the Contractor shall obtain for the Purchaserqs representative, permission to inspect, examine and test as if the equipment were being manufactured on the Contractorqs promises. Such inspection, examination and testing shall not release the Contractor from his obligations under the contract.
- j) The Contractor shall give to the Purchaser adequate time/notice(at least 5 days for inside the State suppliers and 15 days for outside the State suppliers) in writing for inspection of materials indicating the place at which the equipment is ready for testing and inspection and shall also furnish the Routine Test Certificates and Packing List along with offer for inspection to the Purchaser indicating the quantity which can be delivered in full truck load/Mini truck load to facilitate issue of dispatch instruction.

- k) Where the contract provides for test on the Premises of the Contractor or of any of his Sub-Contractors, the Contractor shall provide such assistance, labour, materials, electricity, fuel and instruments as may be required or as may be reasonably demanded by the Purchaserqs representative to carryout such test effectively & efficiently. The Contractor is required to produce Routine Test Certificate before offering their materials for inspection.
- The Purchaser has the right to have the tests carried out at his own cost by an independent agency whenever there is a dispute regarding the quality of supply.

5. Training Facilities

The Contractor shall provide all possible facilities for training of Purchasers Technical personnel, where applicable when deputed by the Purchaser for acquiring first hand knowledge in assembly of the equipment and for its proper operation and maintenance in service if required.

6. Rejection of Materials

In the event any of the materials/equipment supplied by the Contractor is found defective due to faulty design, bad workmanship, bad materials used or otherwise not in conformity with the requirements of the Specification, the Purchaser shall either reject the materials/equipment or ask the Contractor in writing to rectify the same. The Contractor on receipt of such notification shall either rectify or replace the defective equipment free of cost of the Purchaser. If the Contractor fails to do so, the Purchaser may :-

- 2 As its option, replace or rectify such defective equipment and recover the extra costs so involved from the Contractor plus fifteen percent and /or.
- 3 Terminate the contract for balance work/supplies, with enforcement of penalty Clause as per contract for the un-delivered goods and with forfeiture of performance Guarantee/Composite Bank Guarantee.
- 4 Acquire the defective equipment/materials at reduced price, considered equitable under the circumstances.

7.0 Experience of Bidders :

The bidders should furnish information regarding experience particularly on the following points:-

- i) Name of the firm.
 - A list of work orders executed during the last three years along with useros certificates.
 - Equipment capability & upto date calibration certificate(s).

8. Language and Measures

All documents pertaining to the contract including Specifications, Schedule, Notices, Correspondence, Operating & Maintenance instructions, Drawings or any other writing shall be written in English language. The metric system of measurement shall be used exclusively in this contract.

9. Deviation from Specification

It is in the interest of the Tenderers to study the Specification, drawing etc. specified in the tender schedule thoroughly before tendering so that, if any deviations are made by the

Tenderers the same are prominently brought out on a separate sheet under heading Deviations+:

A list of deviation shall be enclosed with the Tender. Unless deviation in scope, technical and commercial stipulations are specifically mentioned in the list of deviations, it shall be presumed that the Tenderer has accepted all the conditions stipulated in the tender Specification, not withstanding any exemptions mentioned therein.

10. Right to Reject/Accept Any Tender

The Purchaser reserves the right either to reject or to accept any or all tenders if the situation so warrants in the interest of the Purchaser. Orders may also be split up between different Tenderers on individual merits of the Tenderer. The Purchaser has exclusive right to alter the quantities of materials at the time of placing final Purchase order. After placing of the rate contract order, the Purchaser may place workorder from time to time after site requirements. It may be clearly understood by the Tenderer that the Purchaser need not, assign any reason for the above action(s).

11. Contractor to inform himself fully

The Contractor shall examine the instructions to Tenderers, General Conditions of contract, Specification and the Schedules of Quantity and delivery to satisfy himself as to all terms and conditions and circumstances affecting the contract price. He shall quote price(s) according to his own views on these matters and understand that additional allowances except as otherwise provided therein will be levied. The Purchaser shall not be responsible for any misunderstanding or incorrect information obtaining by the Contractor other than the information given to the Contractor in writing by the Purchaser.

12. Patent Rights Etc.

The Contractor shall indemnify the Purchaser against all claims, actions, suits and proceedings for the infringement or alleged infringement of any patent design or copy right protected either in the country of origin or in India by the use of any equipment/ materials supplied by the Contractor. But such indemnity shall not cover any use of the equipment, other than for the purpose indicated by or reasonably to be inferred from the Specification.

13. Delivery/ Completion period

- xi) Time being essence of the contract, the work shall be completed within the completion date specified in the contract. The Purchaser, however, reserves the right to reschedule the completion period. The completion period shall be reckoned from the date of placing the Letter or Intent/ work order as may be specified in the LOI/ work order.
- xii) The desired completion period shall not ordinarily exceed more than 3 month.

14. Inspection:

The statuary inspection of electrical installation if required are to be carried out by the contractor by their own cost. The required amount of fee are to be deposited at the appropriate level.

15. Contractor's Default Liability.

The Purchaser may, upon written notice of default to the Contractor, terminate the contract in circumstanced detailed hereunder.

- If in the judgment of the Purchaser, the Contractor fails to complete within the time specified in the contract or within the period for which extension has been granted by the Purchaser in writing in response to written request of the Contractor, &/ or,
- 2. If in the judgment of the Purchaser, the Contractor fails to comply with any of the provisions of this contract.
- ii) In the event Purchaser terminates the contract either in whole or in part as provided in Clause-15(i) of this section, the Purchaser reserves the right to purchase upon such terms and in such a manner as he may deem appropriate work similar to those terminated and the Contractor will be liable to the Purchaser for any additional costs for such similar work and/or for penalty for delay as defined in Clause-23 of this section until such reasonable time as may be required for the final completion of work.
- iii) In the event the Purchase does not terminate the contract as provided in Clause 15(i) of this Section, Contractor shall continue executing the contract, in which case he shall be liable to the Purchaser for penalty for delay as set out in Clause-23 of this Section until the work is accepted. This shall be based only on written request of the contractor and written willingness of Purchaser.

16. Force Majeure:

The Contractor shall not be liable for any penalty for delay or for failure to perform the contract for reasons of force Majeure such as acts of God, acts of the public enemy, acts of Govt., Fires, Floods, Epidemics, Quarantine restrictions, strikes, Freight Embargo, provided that the Contractor shall within ten (10) days from the beginning of such delay notify the Purchaser in writing of the cause of delay, upon which, the Purchaser shall verify the facts and grant such extension as facts justify.

17. Extension of Time.

If the completion of work is delayed due to reasons beyond the control of the Contractor, the Contractor shall without delay give notice to the Purchaser in writing of his claim for an extension of time. The Purchaser on receipt of such notice may agree to extend the contract completion date as may be reasonable but without prejudice to other terms and conditions of the contract.

18. Guarantee Period.

7 The works covered by this Specification should be Guaranteed for satisfactory operation and against defects in design, materials and workmanship for a period of 18 (eighteen) months from the date of commissioning. The above Guarantee Certificate shall be furnished in triplicate to the purchaser for his approval. Any defect noticed during this period should be rectified by the Contractor free of cost to the Purchaser provided such defects are due to faulty design, bad workmanship or bad materials used, upon written notice from the Purchaser.

8 The work failed or found defective during Guarantee period shall have to be guaranteed after repair/replacement for a further period of 12 months from the date of commissioning or 18 months from the date of handing over of work after such repair/replacement which ever is earlier.

19. <u>Bank Guarantee towards Security Deposit, 100% Payment and performance</u> <u>Guarantee.</u>

- ii) The electrical work shall be carried out simultaneously with the building work and will be continued till it is completed satisfactorily along with the completion of essential portions of building work.
- iii) If any minor alterations are found necessary, the contractor shall do the same within the tendered rates.

All cables shall be 1100 volts and shall have been manufactured in accordance with the latest IS specification. The depth & width of the cable trench will 450mm X 450mm. The cable trench will filled up with after laying of cable & break protection from both side & top. The sand filling will be done inside the cable trench. The cable will passes through the road crossing by 150mm RCC hume pipe/75mm GI pipe. All cable should terminated through Copper/Al. cable lugs/ double compression cable gland etc.

EARTHING:

Earthing shall conform to the following specifications. For other details not covered in this specification, relevant Indian standards shall be referred to. TYPES OF EARTH ELECTRODES:

- ii) Pipes earth electrode.
- i) Plate earth electrode

PLATE EARTH ELECTRODE:

For plate electrode minimum dimensions of electrodes shall be as under:

 G.I plate electrode . 600mm x 600m X 8 mm thick. The electrode shall be buried in the ground with its faces vertical and the top not less than 3M below ground level.
 METHOD OF INSTALLING WATERING ARRANGEMENT:

In the case of plate electrode, a watering pipe of 38mm dia of medium class G.I. pipe shall be provided and attached to the top of this pipe for watering the earth. A funnel is to be provided for watering the pit. The GI flat of size 40x 5 mm shall be nut bolted & blazed on the GI plate & will go the earthing of the building. In case of pipe electrode a 40mm x 20mm reducer shall be used for housed in a masonary enclosure of not less than 30cm x 30cm. A cast iron / MS frame with cover and locking arrangement shall be suitably embedded in the masonry enclosure.

LOCATION OF EARTH ELECTRODE:

Normally an earth electrode shall not be situated less than 1.5m from any building. Care shall be taken that the excavations for earth electrode may not affect the column footing or foundations of the building. In such cases the electrodes shall be situated farther away from the building.

The location of the earth electrode will be where the soil has reasonable chance of remaining moist, as far as possible. Entrances, pavements and roadways, are definitely to be avoided for locating the earth electrode.

METHOD OF CONNECTIING EARTHING LEAD TO EARTH ELECTRODE:

In case of plate electrode the earthing lead shall be securely bolted to the plate with two bolts, nuts, checknuts and washers. In the case of pipe earth electrode, it shall be connected by means of a through bolt, nuts, washers and cable socket.

All materials used for connecting the earth lead with electrode shall be tinned brass in case of copper plate electrode. The earthing lead shall be securely connected at the other end to the main board. Loop earthing shall be provided for all mounting of main board and other metal clad switches and distribution fuse boards with not less than 2.5sq. mm insulated copper wire.

The earthing lead from electrode onwards shall be suitably protected from mechanical damage by a 15mm G.I pipe in case of wire and by 40mm dia medium G.I pipe in case of strip. Portions of this protection pipe within ground shall be buried at least 30cm deep (to be increased to 50cm in case of road crossing and pavement). The portion within the building shall be recessed in walls and floors to adequate depth.

In all cases the relevant provisions of rules 33, 61 and 67 of Indian Electricity rules 1956 as amended shall be complied with. Metallic covers or supports of all medium pressure or HT apparatus or conductors shall in all cases be connected to not less than two separate and distinct earths including electrodes.

No earth electrode shall have a greater ohmic resistance than five ohms as measured by an approved earth testing apparatus. In rocky soil the resistance may be eight ohms.

The details design of wiring are as follows:

- (I) The wiring of all AC Machnies points will be with 2x4Sqmm+1x2.5sqmm copper wire.
- (J) The wiring of all Power plugs points will be with 2x2.5Sqmm+1x1.5sqmm copper wire.
- (K) The wiring of all computer plugs point will be with 2x2.5Sqmm+1x1.5sqmm copper wire.
